Job Opportunity Casual Operator/Labourer

The Town of Bishop's Falls is currently accepting applications for casual Operators/Labourers. Casual Operators/Labourers, who are part of the Town's casual call-in list, work in the Public Works and Recreation Departments and are responsible for the following duties:

- Operating heavy equipment to implement public works services and programs. This includes, among other things, snow clearing operations.
- Maintaining the Town's infrastructure. This involves, among other things, working on water, sewer, and road systems (i.e. waterline breaks, sewer issues, and potholes).
- Working in the Pat O'Reilly Memorial Stadium. This involves providing security during events, cleaning facilities, operating the ice resurfacer (and other equipment), and ensuring invoices are signed by user groups.
- Working in the Recreation Department in general. This involves mowing grass throughout town, maintaining flowers, assisting with civic events, and cleaning facilities.

To qualify for this job you need the following:

1. Class 3 (Tandem)
2. Class 5 (Standard Driver's Licence)
3. Class 8 (Traction)
4. Class 9 (Air Brakes)
5. Experience in operating heavy equipment
6. Clean Driver's Abstract (Recent)

It is important to note these positions are casual in nature; therefore, the Town does not guarantee a minimum number or any hours of employment.

Wages, benefits and other employment terms as outlined in the Collective Agreement between the Town and CUPE Local 1349 will apply.
