Municipal Response to COVID-19 Alert Level 2

June 23, 2020

The Bishop's Falls Town Council continues to assess the public health guidance/direction relating to COVID-19, including the provincial alert level system. When the province moves to alert level 2, which is scheduled for June 25, 2020, the municipality will respond as follows:

- (1) The Town Hall will reopen to public access. At most, three (3) members from the public can be in the Town Hall at any given time to ensure physical distancing can be maintained. Please pay attention to door signage and floor markings.
- (2) Council is currently reviewing public health advice regarding playgrounds, including the skateboard park, and will make an announcement soon. Until then, these facilities remain closed.
- (3) The Fallsview Municipal Park will remain closed for camping; however, it is open to public access for recreational salmon angling, walking, running, etc.
- (4) The Community Garden is open to public access. People in the Garden must respect the physical distancing restrictions (i.e. 2 meters apart) unless they are members of the same bubble.
- (5) The Riverside Drive boardwalk is open under physical distancing restrictions. Residents are permitted to walk in one direction, from west to east, and they must respect the physical distancing restrictions (i.e. 2 meters apart) unless they are members of the same bubble.
- (6) The Faulkner Recreation Complex is open for medium-risk outdoor activities (i.e. team field sports); however, spectators must maintain physical distancing.

The Town Council will continue to monitor the situation surrounding COVID-19 and will adjust its response where possible and as required.
